In an incredible show of democratic participation, the Conservative Party of Canada recently concluded its leadership race with the largest number of voting members in Canadian history. A record 174,849 people participated in the election of the new leader which saw the Hon. Erin O'Toole emerge as the winner.

The race featured a wide variety of policy ideas and showed that in a healthy democracy we can respectfully hear the ideas and opinions of those we may not agree with. While different candidates articulated different ideas, the membership has spoken and along with my Conservative Caucus colleagues, we have united behind Erin O'Toole and look forward to offering Canadians a better Canada.

Erin O'Toole brings a wealth of experience to the position and has made it clear that he intends to actively represent all Canadians. You will be

seeing a lot more and hearing a lot more about him as he further introduces himself to all Canadians and I hope you come to see the refreshing type of thoughtful and respectful leadership he brings to Ottawa.

As part of the Official Opposition, we will continue work with the Liberal government during this pandemic, but we will also call on the government to explain their actions and justify their decisions. MEET ERIN O'TOOLE

In 1991 Erin joined the Canadian Forces and was commissioned as an officer in the Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF). Erin's first posting with the RCAF was at 8 Wing in Trenton, Ontario working at the Rescue Coordination Centre on search and rescue operations. He was later posted to 17 Wing in Winnipeg, Manitoba to complete his training as an Air Navigator. He received his wings and in 1997 was posted to 12 Wing in Shearwater, Nova Scotia. Erin flew with 423 Squadron as a Tactical Navigator on the CH-124 (Sea King) Helicopter. Erin was promoted to the rank of Captain and later received the Canadian Forces Decoration (C.D.) for 12 years of faithful service to Canada.



Upon completion of his service in the regular forces in 2000, Erin transferred to the Canadian Forces reserves and attended law school. Erin then spent five years as in-house counsel to one of the world's

largest consumer products companies managing all litigation in Canada and advising management on environmental, commercial and competition issues.

After 12 years of service, Erin retired from the military and spent the next decade working in the private sector as a corporate lawyer. He is a founding member of the Board of Directors for the True Patriot Love Foundation, a charity that serves veterans and military families across Canada.

He has been elected three times in Durham, Ontario. He served as Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister of International Trade before becoming Minister of Veterans Affairs, a beleaguered file he successfully turned around within 10 months at the end of the Stephen Harper government.

For the last two years, Erin served as Shadow Minister of Foreign Affairs. Erin is married to Rebecca and they have two children, Mollie & Jack.
