

our Conservative team has been working hard in Parliament to deliver results that help all Canadians. Amid 40-year-high inflation caused by the Liberal government's tax-and-spend agenda, 1-in-5 Canadians are skipping meals, while 9-in-10 people who don't own a home believe they never will. Things don't have to be this way.

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau has added more to the national debt than all other Prime Ministers combined. This year, Canada's federal debt is projected to reach \$1.22 trillion—that is nearly \$81,000 per household.

The Liberals have no plan to balance the budget or control inflationary deficits. In fact, they voted against creating a plan to balance the budget at their own policy convention.

Amid record-high inflation on food prices, a family of four will spend \$1,065 more on food this year—that is over double the \$467 grocery rebate some families are set to receive.

This government has also made it more expensive for Canadians to fill up their tanks and heat their homes. Even after rebates, the carbon tax will cost the

average family between \$402 and \$842. Families and small businesses can't afford a tripling of the carbon tax.

We need to support hard-working Canadians by lowering taxes and scraping the carbon tax. Canadians need to bring home more of their paycheques to afford the basics.

Canadians feel unsafe walking the streets and taking public transit as crime rates skyrocket. The Liberal's soft -on-crime and catch-and-release policies have led to a 32% rise in violent crime and a 92% rise in gang-related homicides. We need to target the small number of repeat violent offenders instead of law abiding hunters and sport shooters.

Conservatives are working hard to make a difference where we can. It is not easy to get Liberal and NDP support for our common sense policies, but in this mailing I have highlighted some important successes.

FIGHTING FOR CANADIANS

Conservatives have been laser-focused on delivering for Canadians on the cost-of-living crisis, restoring safe streets, and holding the Liberal government (which enjoys the unwavering support of the NDP) to account. Please take moment to review our efforts and let me know what you think by replying to the survey.



We forced multiple votes to pressure the Liberal government to immediately cancel the tripling of his inflationary carbon tax. Amid 40-year high inflation, the Liberal carbon tax will force Canadian households to pay more for gas, groceries, and home heating than what they will get back in rebates. It is a tax on everything. DEFEATED



We introduced a Motion to kill Bill C-11, the Liberal/NDP online censorship act. While they try to control what you see and say online, Conservatives will continue to fight for your freedom of speech. It should not be up to a group of government-appointed censors to determine what Canadians should be viewing on their favourite websites. DEFEATED



We supported farmers by calling on the Liberal government to cancel the carbon tax on food inputs and production that costs Canadian farmers around \$150,000 per year. This will help keep food prices lower. PASSED



We pushed the Liberals to end their soft-oncrime policies and enact bail reform policies that would prioritize the rights of victims and law-abiding citizens. Amid a 32% rise in violent crime, provinces and police have been calling for better laws while the Liberal/ NDP government did nothing. DEFEATED



We forced on the Liberal government to cancel its unfair and costly April 1st tax increase on beer, wine, and spirits.

Tax increases should not be automatic.

PASSED



We held the Liberal government accountable by forcing an audit into their costly and ineffective pandemic ArriveCan app. The program failed to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as they had promised. PASSED



We pushed the costly Liberal-NDP coalition to cap spending, cut waste, fire high-priced consultants, and eliminate inflationary deficits and taxes that have caused a cost-of-living crisis for Canadians. Canadians are paying more and more for public services, but getting less and less. DEFEATED



We demanded accountability on what the Liberal Government knew and when they knew it on Beijing's interference in Canada's elections. It is unacceptable that the Liberal government did not do anything to stop foreign governments from targeting Canadian politicians. This complete failure to protect Canadians from being threatened at home and abroad strikes at the heart of Canadian democracy. ON-GOING



We called on the Liberal government to stop all new taxes on gas, groceries, home heating, and paycheques. Inflation on most basic groceries is above 10%. We need to focus on making sure Canadians can afford the basics as life gets more and more expensive. (When inflation rates are at 8% it has the effect of cutting a full month's pay from your purchasing power each year.) DEFEATED



We forced the Liberal government to delay the expansion of medically-assisted death to those whose only qualifying condition was mental illness. Those suffering from mental health challenges need support and access to treatment, not a quicker, easier path to ending their lives. PASSED

GETTING LEGISLATION PASSED FOR ALL CANADIANS



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-228 will protect pensions from corporate insolvency by making pensions and group insurance plan payments a priority in bankruptcy proceedings.



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-291 will protect children from sexual exploitation by taking a stronger stand against child sexual abuse and exploitation materials.



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-234 will remove the carbon tax from qualifying farm fuels and lower the cost of food.



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-242 will make it easier to reunite families by allowing a parent or grandparent to visit Canada longer. It also makes it easier for them to purchase the required health insurance before they visit Canada.



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-241 will support Canada's hardworking tradespeople by allowing them to deduct their travel expenses from their taxes. This is important because we need to do more to address critical labour shortages across Canada.



PASSED: Conservative Bill C-288 that will increase transparency of telecommunications marketing so that Canadians know what internet speeds they are paying for.

CURRENTLY UNDER DEBATE



Conservative Bill C-325 will prevent people convicted of certain crimes from serving their sentence in the community.



Conservative Bill C-321 will require a court to consider the fact that the victim of an assault is a health care professional or a first responder to be an aggravating circumstance for the purposes of sentencing.



Conservative Bill C-323 will exempt psychotherapy and mental health counselling services from the goods and services tax (GST).



Conservative Bill C-280 will amend the Bankruptcy Act to reclassify fresh produce as non-assets to better protect farmers.
